Leaside Church is accessible from Ware High Street and is situated through a passage, next to 'Parkers', a jewellers, near to the Isabel Hospice Charity Shop, opposite the TSB.

The nearest car-park is in Kibes Lane, along East Street away from the High Street. The car-park is Pay and Display but is free on Sundays and in the evening.

There is a drop-off space in front of the entrance alleyway.

The New Reception Area

This provides a glazed covered link between the Church and Hall creating for the first time a single building to be known as Leaside Church & Community Centre.



This is now the main entrance leading to both Church and Hall, including a ramp to give wheelchair access to all areas.



There are now new unisex accessible toilets.

The Church

From the outset of this project the intention was to make Leaside more usable, not just for Sunday Worship, but for the use of the whole community during all of the week.

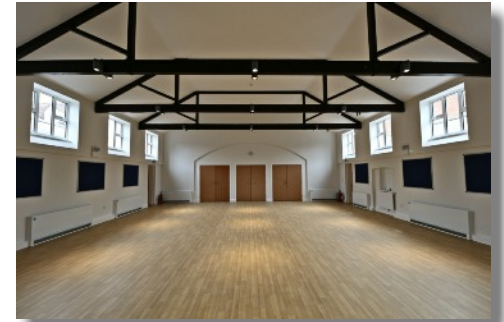


The work to the Church began in 2010, and has now been added to with a new tea and coffee point for refreshments, and reinforcement of the gallery providing an additional 50 seats, a total of 150 for concerts and other meetings.



The Hall

The hall building has been completely refurbished to bring it up to 21st Century standards and give a warm, bright, welcoming space whilst reducing energy use.



We now have a large open space in the main hall, used by Leaside Under Fives Kindergarten in school time, but available evenings and weekends for use by all.



The original smaller room has been renamed the Isabel Adams Room and is dividable into two to give more versatility to this space.
