### How to prepare for Sing Resurrection

Sing resurrection is taking place at a critical time and for that reason, it is very important that how it takes place is given careful thought and consideration. Here are some suggestions as to make sure that everything is well prepared:

1. Prayer. Pray that all that is done in connection with Sing Resurrection will be pleasing to God, uplifting for all who take part and all who listen in, and that it will indeed be a counter-infection of joy and hope at this time. You may like to use [this prayer](#) for Sing Resurrection.
2. Keeping to Government Guidelines. It is vitally important that everything that happens in connection with Sing Resurrection conforms to the guidelines. No gatherings must be organised in connection with Sing Resurrection.
3. What can be organised. Whilst keeping strictly to government guidelines, some kinds of prior coordination may be arranged. To give an example: If there are a number of people who want to take part and who live around a town square or village green, it would be permitted for them to agree in advance to stand by their front door or garden gate and sing together. However it would not be permitted for them to gather in the square or on the village green, even if they kept spatial distance.
4. Informing your neighbours. It is important to be sensitive to your neighbours. We suggest that you inform them in advance about Sing Resurrection. You can give them an option of joining in by pointing them to where lyrics can be found on the website, or invite them to listen out for you.
