Every day approximately 8 million pieces of plastic pollution find their way into our oceans.

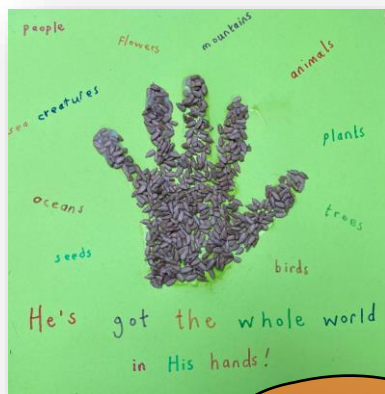
Nearly 40% of plants on the planet are at risk of extinction.

What could you do to protect the earth at home?

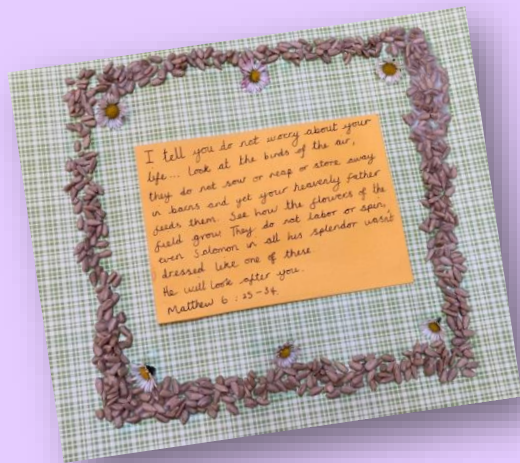
What could you do to protect the earth at school?
